#### Receiving Communion and One-On-One Prayer

Christ welcomes all to communion. Those Baptized in any Christian tradition are encouraged to receive communion.

- Receive the bread in open and outstretched hands and sip the wine, guiding the chalice to your lips. If you do not want to sip the wine, it is also perfectly appropriate to receive the bread only. If you wish to intinct, or dip the wafer in the wine, please hold the wafer in such a way that the Eucharistic Minister can intinct it and hand it back to you. Please do not intinct the wafer yourself. Gluten-free wafers are also available by request. Respond to communion by saying "Amen." If you prefer a blessing, cross your hands over your chest. Baptism is offered several times yearly; speak to the priest to learn more.
  - If you wish to pray one-on-one with a Prayer Minister, go to the rear of the sacnturary after receiving communion or a blessing. Prayer ministers hold all requests in absolute confidence.
