The Rev. Suzanne Findlen Hood is the 20th Rector of Trinity. She begins this role in November 2025.

Suzanne joined The Episcopal Church as an adult, finding that it invited her theological exploration while also sharing many liturgical similarities with the Roman Catholic Church in which she was raised. During her first career, Suzanne was an active lay member of the church, serving on the Vestry and as Senior Warden, as a eucharistic minister, on the worship committee, and as a delegate to Diocesan Convention. In 2017 she discerned her call to ordination and after seminary was ordained deacon and priest in 2022 in the Diocese of Virginia. Prior to her call to Trinity, Suzanne served as Associate Rector at Christ Church, New Bern in the Diocese of East Carolina.

Suzanne earned her Master of Divinity from Virginia Theological Seminary in Alexandria, Virginia, in 2022. Her earlier degrees include a B.A. in history from Wheaton College in Norton, Massachusetts, awarded in 1997, and an M.A. in Early American Material Culture from the Winterthur Program, University of Delaware in 2001. In her previous career, Suzanne was Curator of Ceramics and Glass at Colonial Williamsburg.

Suzanne and her husband Jorin love spending time outdoors, taking long walks, and listening to the birds. Suzanne enjoys reading, putting together jigsaw puzzles, cooking, and travel. She is a native of Maine and many of her happiest moments are spent swimming in the pond where her parents live.
